



Project: Digital Tools for Inclusion of Refugees, Asylum Seekers and Migrants

Madrid Transnational Partners Meeting and Multiplier Event

The project partners met in Madrid, Spain on 28th-30th May for their last transnational meeting of the European project 'Digital Tools for Inclusion of Refugees, Asylum Seekers and Migrants' as scheduled in the timetable, under the auspices of Sant'Egidio Madrid. During the welcome session the host organisation presented their activities for helping refugees and immigrants in Madrid. The partners reviewed the project progress and agreed on the deadlines for the activities in the last project phase.

On 30th May the Project Coordinator – DG of Social Services and Social Integration at the Community of Madrid- convened the multiplier event at Casa de Correos (headquarters of Madrid Regional Government). The audience was composed of civil society, public and private entities, including project beneficiaries as refugees, immigrants and third country nationals from the six partner countries. Some staff members of the project presented the rationale and development of the project to the participants.

Amongst the guest speakers, representatives from Spanish and the Autonomous Community of Madrid governments described the Spanish system for the Reception and Integration of refugees and asylum seekers, with detailed statistical data and practical issues. Several NGO's presented good practice examples, which showed the importance of the role of citizenship in liaison with European governments.
